This latest development comes as clinicians have discussed potential 5 mm BOZD benefits during several conference presentations over the past year. "My experience is that the 5 mm design offers significantly more paracentral steepening compared to a 6 mm zone, which may lead to more efficacy when pursuing myopia management strategies, assuming a dose-depending relationship between the amount of paracentral steepening and ortho-k's anti-myopia effect," she said.
